## 8. Overall progress since the implementation of the project:

Clonal trials of *Melia dubia* have been established in an area of 0.2 hectares in Anaikatti, Panampally, Mathilakam, and Pathanamthitta Kerala. Annual growth performance is recorded for the trials, and the trials are being maintained. The best-performing clones for different locations were identified. The project is extended up to Dec 2025.
